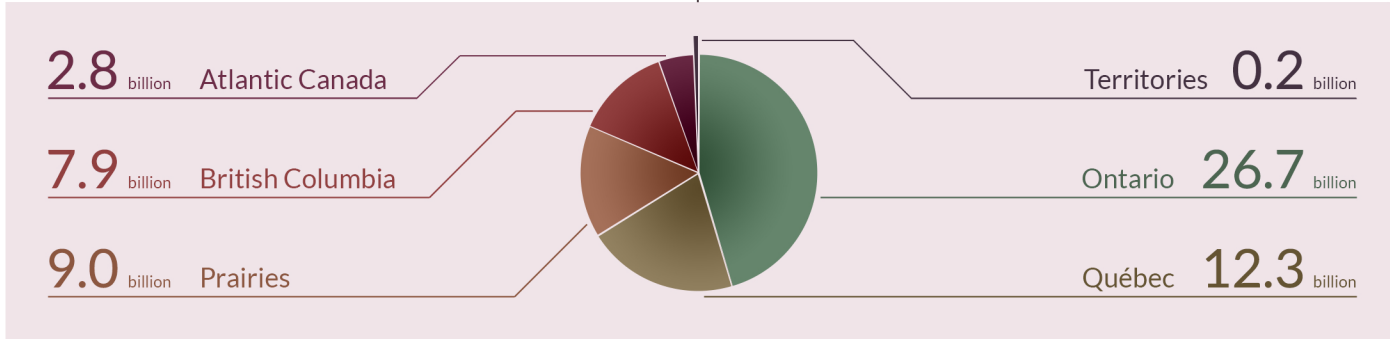
ATLANTIC CANADA CULTURAL SECTOR

THE REGION AT A GLANCE

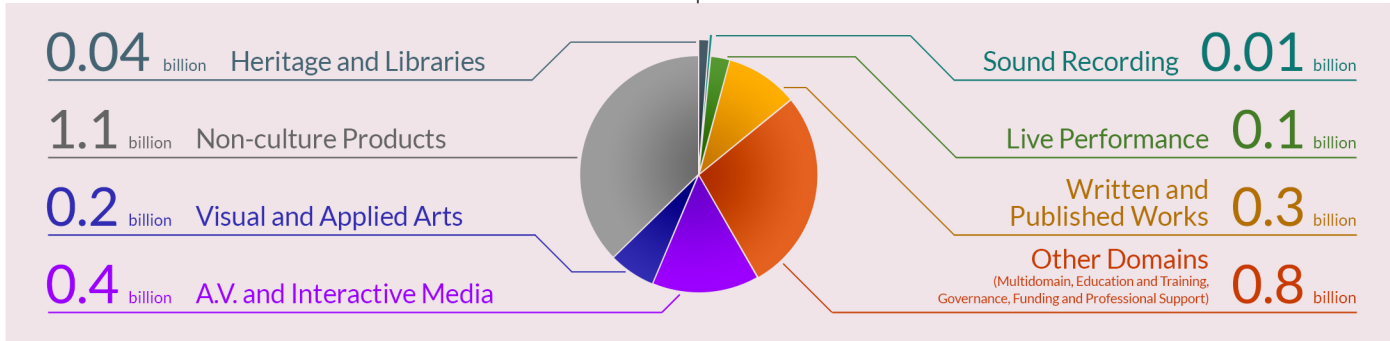
While Atlantic Canada accounts for roughly 5% of Canada's cultural sector (on a GDP and employment basis), there are cultural domains that are much more prevalent in the region than what the region's population would suggest. These include: **Heritage and Libraries**, **Live Performance** and **Sound Recording**.

Demographic and economic projections suggest a limited potential growth of the overall cultural sector in the region. However, the outlook suggests potential growth especially in the **Heritage and Libraries**, **Live Performance** and **Visual and Applied Arts** domains.

REGIONAL BREAKDOWN OF CULTURAL SECTOR GDP (\$ BILLION)



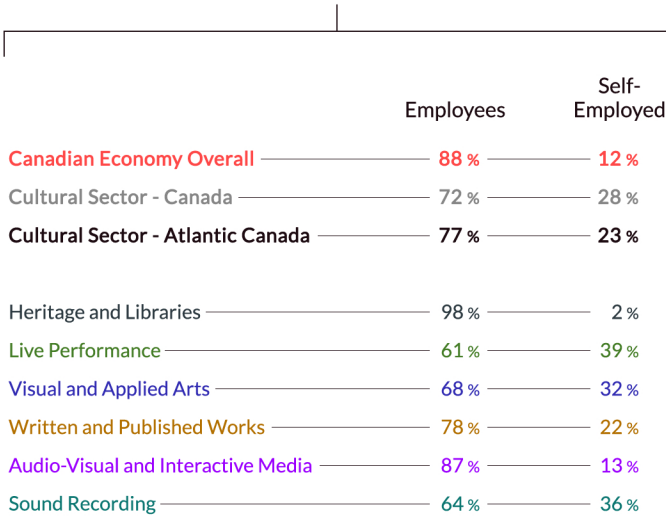
BREAKDOWN OF CULTURAL SECTOR GDP BY DOMAIN (\$ BILLION) ATLANTIC CANADA

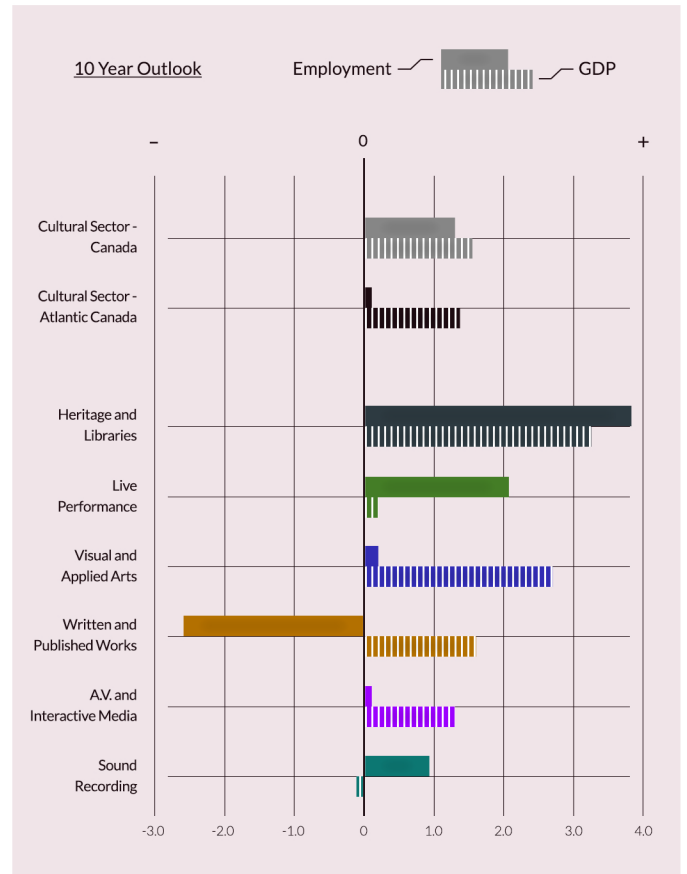
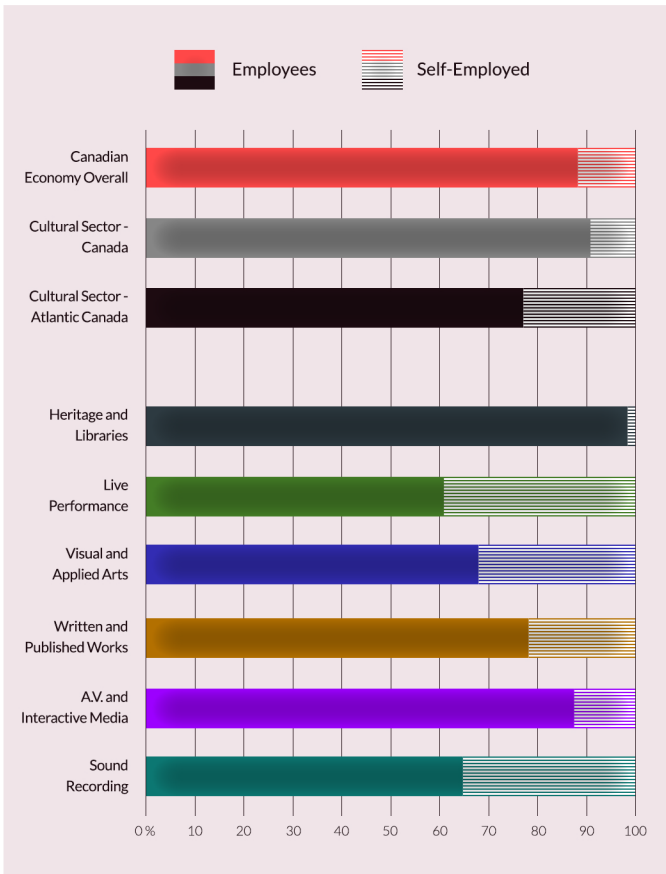
EMPLOYMENT STATUS

10-YEAR OUTLOOK BY DOMAIN (% AVG. ANNUAL INCREASE)



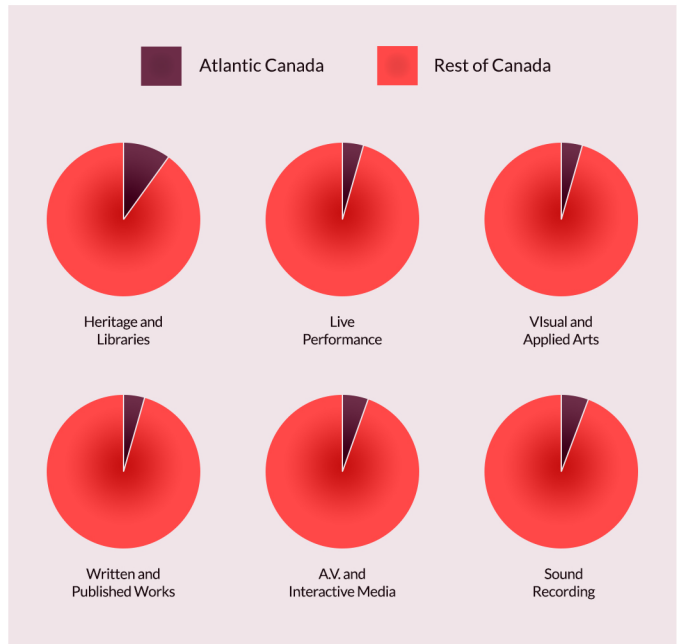
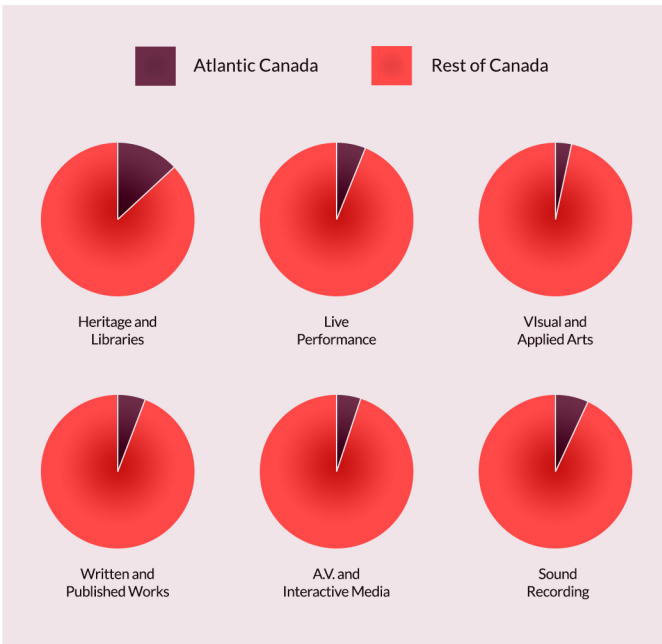
