## QUÉBEC CULTURAL SECTOR

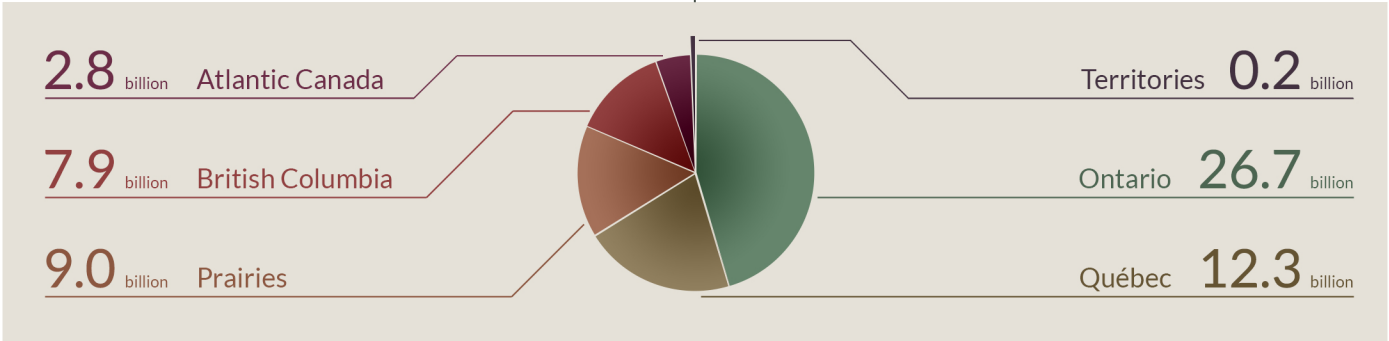
### THE REGION AT A GLANCE

Quebec's cultural sector is a particularly important segment of the Quebec economy given the relatively large share of workers in cultural occupations that reside in the province and the large share of cultural establishments that are located in the province.

Overall, Quebec's cultural sector is the second largest in the country - accounting for 21% of the GDP attributed by the national cultural sector.

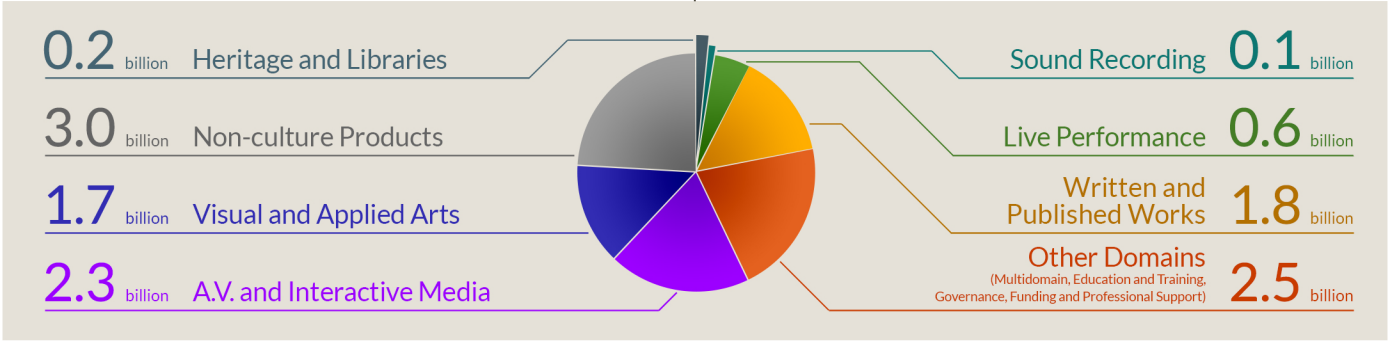
The outlook suggests that the sector will continue to expand, aided by solid growth in Heritage and Libraries, Live Performance, Audio-Visual and Interactive Media and Sound Recording domains.

### BREAKDOWN OF CULTURAL SECTOR GDP BY DOMAIN (\$ BILLION)

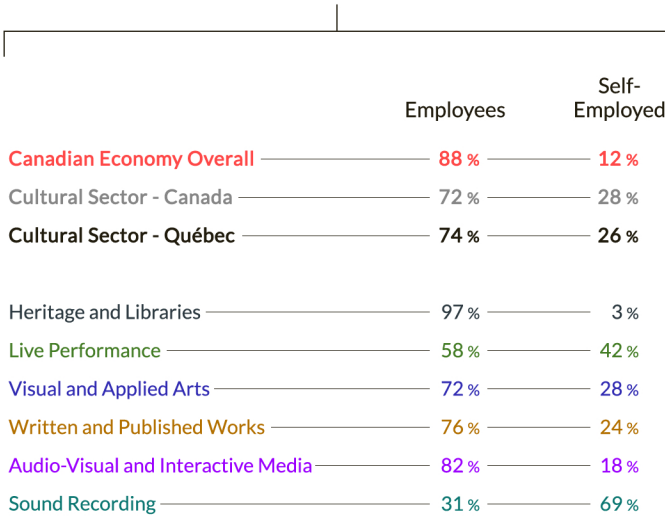

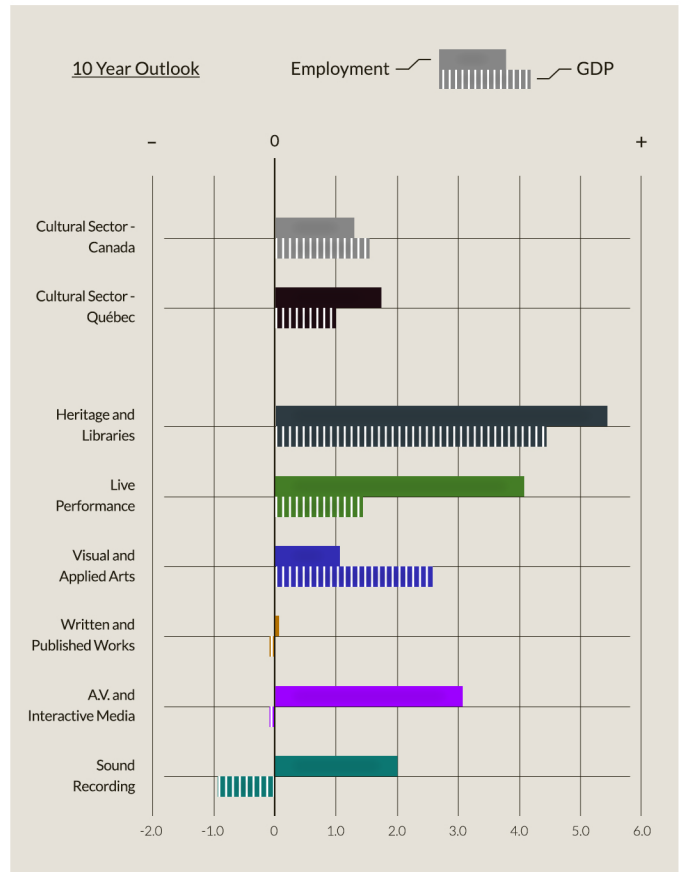
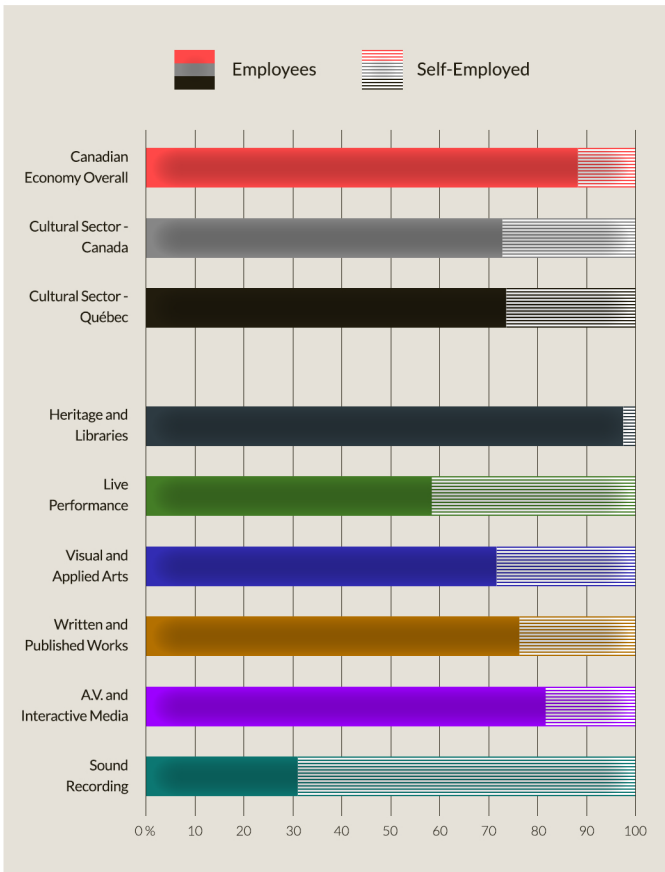
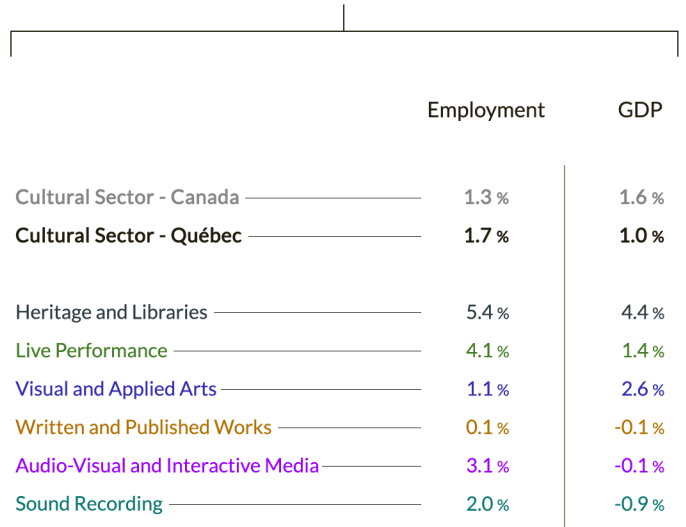
## EMPLOYMENT STATUS

10-YEAR OUTLOOK BY DOMAIN (% AVG. ANNUAL INCREASE)



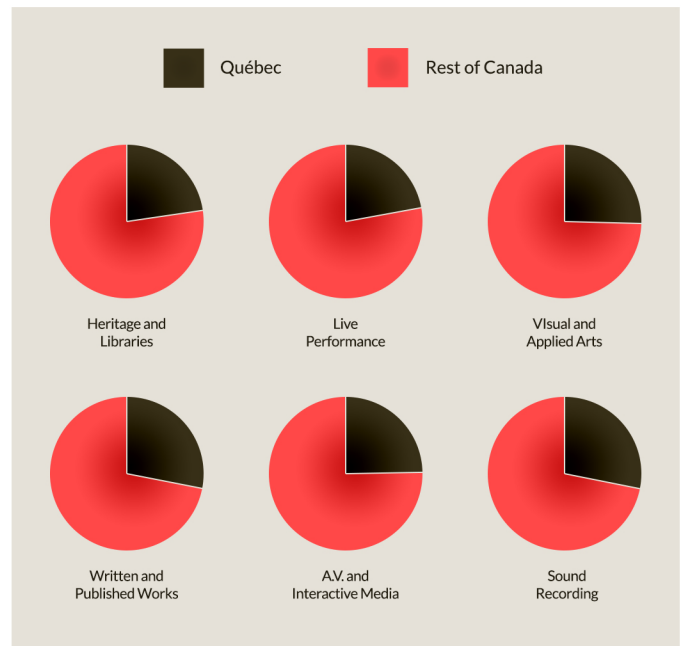
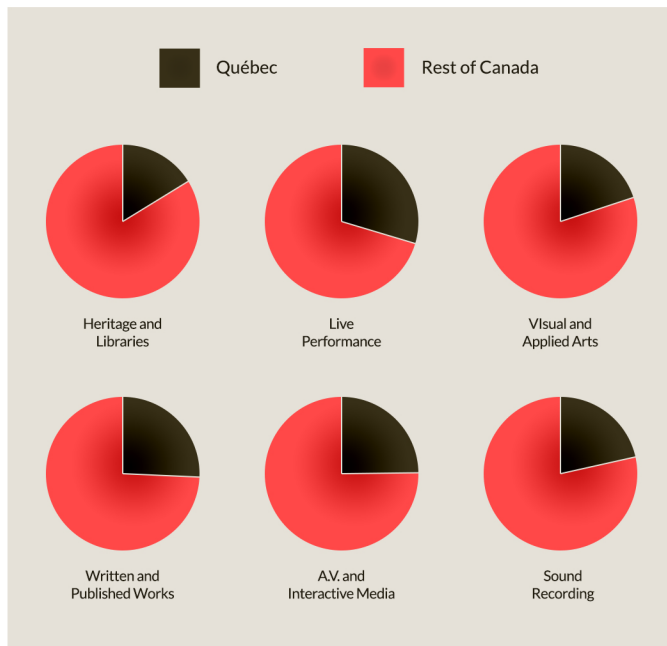
